Picnics at the Y

Whether it's a family reunion, company picnic, or any other social gathering, our picnic grove (nestled under large pine trees) is the perfect place. With open fields, volleyball courts, sheltered pavilions, numerous picnic tables, and even large grills; we have what you need.



Hayes Lodge Rentals

Hayes Lodge is open year round for any function that you need. This spacious, full service, winterized lodge can seat over 100 people. All functions include tables and/or chairs, with a TV, VCR/DVD, overhead projector, and easel with dry erase or paper upon request. The lodge also has a small kitchen with refrigerator/freezer, oven, and microwave for any food preparation needs. We also have our own Karaoke Machine that can be used at any event. Some of the more common functions that utilize Hayes Lodge are board meetings, community gatherings, private parties, and staff trainings, although it can be used for just about anything.

Our Outdoor Education programs are designed to encourage an understanding of our natural surroundings and foster individual or group growth through guided discovery, hands-on experiences, physical challenges, and team-learning.

Courses are adapted to the ages and learning levels of all participants in this experiential approach to outdoor and personal enrichment. Our environmental education classes are intended to heighten everyone's knowledge of our natural surroundings, or to be a useful tool for teachers as an extension of the traditional school curriculum and can assist schools in meeting state and local curriculum requirements.
