Teachers will lead youth classes and be able to make adjustments to curriculum based on skill development. The preferred candidates will have basic pre-school and youth gymnastics experience. Cheerleading and tumbling experience is also accepted! Successful candidates must be willing to take the initiative and be committed to growing and creating a fun gymnastics program. We will train and mentor the right candidate who may have little to no experience.

The schedule is Tuesdays 3:30-6:30 P.M. and Saturdays 8:30-11:30 A.M.

Qualifications:

1. Experience and/or knowledge of gymnastics
2. Must be able to demonstrate basic skills if the need arises
3. Previous experience working with children
4. Ability to form positive interactions with youth and families
5. Strong communication skills, ability to help youth grow personally and achieve goals
6. Previous experience with diverse populations preferred
7. Be a positive role model
8. First Aid and CPR certified preferred

Work Environment & Physical Demands:
