POSITION SUMMARY:

Assist a Senior Counselor in the supervision of a group of children in a seasonal day camp. Provides a quality experience to children and parents focused on YMCA core values: honesty, respect, responsibility, and caring. Camp dates are June 24 – August 23 with staff training likely the week of June 17. Approximate hours are 8:15am – 4:15pm, M-F. We occasionally hire staff that can work part-time, or outside those hours.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Assists in supervising a group of 10 -20 children ensuring their safety and enjoyment of camp.
2. Assists in planning and implementing program activities that is culturally relevant, developmentally appropriate, and consistent with YMCA values.
3. Attends staff meetings and trainings.
4. Build authentic and positive relationships with all campers within group.
5. Engage with and supervise children using positive guidance and support methods.
6. Prepare for and actively participate in scheduled swim time. (1 staff must swim with group.)
7. Ensure that head counselor is given proper documentation and made aware of all behavior challenged, injuries and incidents that occur throughout the day, in a timely manner.
8. Prepare for and actively participate in camp activities that include dress up days.
9. Respond to feedback in a timely manner
10. Attend and participate in family nights, program activities, staff meetings/trainings, and professional development
11. Represent yourself and the Metrowest YMCA in a positive and professional manner.
12. Understand, follow, and enforce the safety and health regulations set forth by the YMCA and the Department
13. Maintains positive relations with parents and other staff.
14. Assisting with other duties as assigned by the Unit Leader and/or Leadership team.

YMCA COMPETENCIES (Leader):

Mission Advancement: Accepts and demonstrates the Y's values. Demonstrates a desire to serve others and fulfill community needs. Recruits volunteers and builds effective, supportive working relationships with them. Supports fund-raising.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Be at least 16 years of age and have completed Sophomore Year of high school or equivalent.
2. Previous experience working with children preferred, ideally in a day camp setting.
3. Experience preferred in one or more of the following areas: outdoor living, archery, boating, camping, songs/music, skits, sports, aquatics, recreational games, etc...
4. All Redwoods trainings within 30 days of hire date.
5. Previous experience with diverse populations preferred.
6. Pediatric and Adult First Aid and CPR certification preferred.

Ability to support and participate in a range of activities in a variety of outdoor/indoor settings. Maintain a neat and orderly appearance adhering to the MetroWest YMCA Day Camp dress code. Be able to lift a minimum of 50lbs. Updated health form on file.
